ABOUT TODAY'S ART AND MUSIC

The art on the cover depicts the scene in today's Gospel when a man with wealth walks away, sorrowfully, from Jesus' call. It is from James Tissot's *The Life of Our Lord Jesus Christ*, a compilation of 350 watercolor paintings rendered between 1886-1896 that chronicle the entire life of Jesus as recorded in the New Testament. To research the project, Tissot traveled to Syria, Egypt, and Palestine several times, closely observing the landscape and architecture, conducting interviews, and doing scholarly research. He aimed to render images as close as possible to eyewitness accounts of Jesus' life. *Rich Young Man Went Away Sorrowful* is reprinted here with permission under the Creative Commons Attribution Noncommercial License of Vanderbilt University.
