Here's a little more about the chaplains:

- Pastor Ben Adams recently returned to his home state of Michigan, after ten years in Chicago, where he graduated from the Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago then served seven years in campus ministry in the city. The focus of Pr. Ben's ministry is on building powerful relationships, extending grace to all, and making space for equitable, inclusive, counter-cultural community to grow.
- The Rev. Matthew Lukens was originally born and raised a Southern Baptist in Alabama and found the Episcopal Church through campus ministry at the University of Virginia (where he met Rev. Emily as well!). In the last decade, he's worked with young adults, the LGBTQ+ community, two quiet parishes in Hawaii, and building-less churches asking fundamental questions about the commitment of their resources to build up the community around them.
- The Rev. Dr. Donna McNiell serves both as the campus missionary for Canterbury House MSU and the Associate Rector for Youth at All Saints', East Lansing. She previously has served as a campus minister at Missouri State University, University of Delaware, and Pacific Coast University, and also as a middle school chaplain. She has a Doctor of Ministry degree in mission from Episcopal Divinity School.
