

Job Opportunity Youth & Family Ministry Coordinator

Christ Church Detroit seeks a Youth & Family Ministry Coordinator to facilitate youth programming on Sunday mornings and on other occasions. The Coordinator joins a team of dedicated lay and clergy leaders to build connections and manage logistics for both signature and new educational opportunities.

Classification: Part Time, Non-Exempt

Compensation: \$21/hour, 10 months of the year

Hours: 10-12 hours/week during the school year; work in person on Sundays from at least 8:30am-12:30pm; during the rest of the week, some work can be done remotely

Responsibilities:

- Create & maintain settings for spiritual imagination, exploration, and belonging
 - Help implement a Godly Play program for our elementary children, a new young adult exploration program, and existing signature teen programs
 - o Recruit, schedule, and equip nursery staff and volunteer teachers
 - Lead some lessons and activities, working alongside team members
 - Maintain the classrooms and supplies
 - Collaborate with Youth Choir Director, teachers, and clergy to help students lead worship, including the annual Christmas Pageant
- Build connections among and beyond church members
 - o Plan and run family-centered activities & events
 - Coordinate regular communications with Sunday School families
 - Help publicize our youth programs among current families and other families in Detroit and surrounding areas
 - Provide pastoral support for families and communicate concerns with the Rector
 - Meet weekly with the Rector to review programs, prepare for upcoming events, and brainstorm new possibilities

Qualifications:

- Energy and passion for education, imagination, and spiritual belonging
- Love and respect for families of all shapes, sizes, backgrounds, and means
- Belief that God loves everyone—no exceptions. We are an affirming congregation that advocates for and celebrates diversity, inclusion, and equity.
- Experience working with children, youth, and families, preferably in faith-based or nonprofit settings
- Experience with event coordination and volunteer management
- Strong proven interpersonal, communication, and digital skills
- Ability to relate to and foster authentic relationships with our youth and parents
- Reliability, including being on-time and present during pre-arranged times
- Experience with the Episcopal Church is a bonus, but not necessary for the right candidate
- A background check and completion of Safe Church training are required for the chosen candidate before they can start work
- Willingness to participate in professional development and trainings (paid for by the church)
